## Visa Information

The visa application form is available free of charge at all Singapore overseas missions (except for non-resident High Commissioners/Ambassadors based in Singapore). You may also download the form [here](#). The list of our Overseas Missions is available [here](#). You should approach the nearest Mission directly for more information on the requirements and procedures to apply for a visa.

You may also wish to apply for a visa through a local contact in Singapore who is a Singapore citizen or a Permanent Resident in possession of a "Singpass" account. The visa application can be submitted online through your local contact in Singapore via the SAVE system at Singapore Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA)'s website [www.ica.gov.sg](http://www.ica.gov.sg). After ICA processes the application, the local contact in Singapore can print out or collect the visa at ICA and mail it to you.

## Visa and Entry Requirements for Foreigners

All visitors to Singapore must meet the following entry requirements:

- Valid travel document (minimum validity of 6 months at the time of departure)
- Confirmed onward or return tickets (if applicable)
- Entry facilities, including visas, to the next destination;
- Sufficient funds to maintain themselves during their stay in Singapore; and,
- Visa for entry into Singapore (if applicable)
- Yellow Fever Vaccinations (if applicable)
